PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Navarro County 100 Club Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to selected students to help cover the cost of education or technical training beyond high school. Scholarship recipients are selected by a Scholarship Committee. Emphasis will be placed on financial need, leadership, extra-curricular activities and character.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Any current year graduate of a Navarro County high school or a current college student. The applicant **must** be an immediate family member of a current or former Navarro County Law Enforcement Officer. The applicant has been accepted to an accredited college, university, or technical college and has maintained a 2.5 GPA in high school.

WHAT IS THE TERM OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The Navarro County 100 Club scholarship is a one-year, one time payment scholarship. A recipient may reapply each year for a total of four years.

HOW MANY SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE AND WHAT IS THEIR VALUE?

The number of scholarships varies from year to year. The scholarship(s) can be up to \$1,500 per year.

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO REAPPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The student will be required to maintain full time status (12 or more semester hours) with a 2.5 or better GPA. The student will be required to submit an official grade report in writing to the Navarro County 100 Club scholarship committee with their application.

WHERE CAN I RECEIVE AN APPLICATION?

Interested students can pick up an application from your high school Counselor or the Navarro County 100 Club.

WHEN IS THE DEADLINE?

Completed application **must be mailed and received by Friday**, **March 29**, **2024**. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

WHEN WILL THE SCHOLARSHIP BE PRESENTED?

The recipient(s) of the scholarship(s) will be notified by phone and will be presented the scholarship at the students' Awards/Senior Days at their High Schools.
